Maryland Network Against Domestic Violence



K. Tony Korol-Evans, Ph.D., *Statewide Trainer.* Dr. Korol-Evans is the Statewide Trainer for the Maryland Network Against Domestic Violence (MNADV). Her focus is on new training initiatives for domestic violence service providers (DVSPs) across Maryland and technical assistance provision, including on issues of sheltering, trauma, and improving response for survivors of human trafficking and military service members, veterans, and their families experiencing intimate partner violence. Tony has presented on numerous topics regarding power-based violence including Crisis Intervention; Diversity, Allyship, and Advocacy; Intersections of Intimate Partner Violence & Sexual Assault; Military-Civilian Connections; Neurobiology of Trauma; Professional Ethics & Boundaries; Safety Planning; and improving services for numerous underserved populations. The trainings on underserved populations that Dr. Korol-Evans has presented on include providing response for victims who are: people of color; members of the Lesbian, Gay, Bisexual, and Transgender (LGBT) communities; men and boys; and persons with disabilities, among others. Prior to working with MNADV, she was the Training & Outreach Specialist and Division Manager for the Maryland Coalition Against Sexual Assault. Tony worked diligently to facilitate the relationship between the military and civilian sexual assault service providers in Maryland. She was also the Follow-Up Program Specialist and Safe Helpline Manager for the Department of Defense (DoD) Safe Helpline, an online and phone helpline for members of the military who had survived sexual trauma. Earlier in her career, Dr. Korol-Evans was a Planning Board Member for the TAMAR (Trauma, Abuse, Mental Health, And Recovery) Project, a program that helped incarcerated women with histories of child sexual abuse successfully transition back to the community. Tony received her Interdisciplinary Ph.D. in Theatre & Drama from Northwestern University and both her M.A. & B.A. from the University of Maryland - College Park.
